Consequences

Depending on the severity of the player's violation of the Volleyball BC Code of Conduct and Ethics, the consequences will vary. Consequences range from not playing, to being removed from the team. Less severe issues will be dealt with at the personal discretion of the coach; more severe issues may lead to the athlete being removed from the team and will be dealt with by the executive. Athletes choosing to break team rules or violate the Code of Conduct and Ethics may be sent home immediately at the expense of the parents. Athletes will not be reimbursed any of their club fees or additional costs when they have been removed from the team, or undergoing consequences.
